One of the ways you can be a part of **We.Go** is through the outreach ministry called **A.C.T.S.** (Advancing Community Through Service) based on scripture that urges Christ followers to not be hearers only of the Word, but to *Act on what you hear!* (James 1:22 MSG)

Every Wednesday night through the months of June and July the people of Lifepoint will be sent out into Chillicothe to do community service projects and engage our neighbors with the Gospel.

We will gather in our purple **We.Go** t-shirts at Lifepoint at 5:30 to grab a hotdog, bag of chips and a bottle of water and then break off into our various project groups for assignments and prayer. Project work will be done from 6-8pm and conclude with a presentation of a Bible signed by all the volunteers who worked on each project to the homeowner.

Project work might include painting, yard work, cleaning gutters, home repair, small building projects and much more! We usually have about 4-5 projects going on each Wednesday, so you can choose what is best suited for the way God has gifted you. If you are unable to do physical work, we also have a group that goes into the nursing homes to minister to them.

Childcare is available at the church for children ages birth to kindergarten. We encourage children ages 1st-5th grade to go with their parents on the projects so they can learn what serving others through meeting practical needs looks like or to go to the nursing home. Middle school and high school students will meet at the church with Pastor Mark for their own bible study time and service projects.

Please make plans this summer to be a part of A.C.T.S and be a blessing to our community. As we encounter the world the world encounters the gospel!




## Opportunities To Pray
